(3) Revocation or suspension by court order of any
contractor's license or any applicable certificate of
authorization from the public utilities commission.
Each day of violation shall constitute a separate offense. In

forfeiture pursuant to chapter 712A."
SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
begun before its effective date.
