SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE UNITED STATES CONGRESS, POSTAL REGULATORY
COMMISSION, AND UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE TO TAKE ANY
ACTIONS NECESSARY FOR THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE TO
LEASE TO PRIVATE BUSINESSES ADVERTISING SPACE ON POSTAL
PROPERTY.

1 WHEREAS, the United States Postal Service reaches every
2 address in the United States and delivers forty-eight percent of
3 the world's mail; and

4
5 WHEREAS, the United States Postal Service has operated at a
6 loss since 2007, with the service incurring a net loss of
7 \$473,000,000 in fiscal year 2022; and

9 WHEREAS, the United States Postal Service's revenues are
10 derived from the sale of postage stamps, products, and services;
11 and

13 WHEREAS, there is an essential need for additional revenue
14 for infrastructural improvements at postal offices nationwide;
15 and

17 WHEREAS, revenue from leasing advertising space on postal
18 property will facilitate implementation of these essential
19 infrastructural improvements; now, therefore,

21 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-second
22 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2023, the
23 House of Representatives concurring, that the United States
24 Congress, Postal Regulatory Commission, and United States Postal
25 Service are requested to take any actions necessary for the
26 United States Postal Service to lease to private businesses
27 advertising space on postal property; and

29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
30 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Postmaster General
