
SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU TO RELOCATE THE BUS
TURNAROUND OFF MAKAU STREET TO KEAAU BEACH PARK OR THE
SURROUNDING AREA.

1 WHEREAS, Makau Street is located in a residentially zoned
2 neighborhood in Waianae, Oahu, situated between the world famous
3 Makaha Beach Park to the south and Keaau Beach Park to the
4 north; and

5
6 WHEREAS, due to the Makau Street neighborhood's idyllic and
7 rural location, there are two public bus routes that service the
8 area, known as TheBus's "Route C CountryExpress!" and "Route 93
9 Waianae Coast Express", by going past Kili Drive, exiting off of
10 Farrington Highway and onto Lawaia Street, and thereafter using
11 Makau Street to turn back eastbound on Farrington Highway; and

12
13 WHEREAS, Makau Street is a relatively narrow, unmarked two-
14 way street encompassed by curbside parking on both sides, which
15 can require pedestrians to enter the street to bypass parked
16 cars; and

17
18 WHEREAS, many beachgoers and children use Makau Street to
19 access the popular Makaha Beach Park, and residents have
20 complained of speeding buses, which cause near accidents; and

21
22 WHEREAS, Makau Street has also been beleaguered recently by
23 approximately thirteen water main breaks, and many residents
24 have observed that the breaks have been repeatedly occurring
25 near the corner where the heavy Route C double-buses exact
26 pressure as they go around the southwest corner and accelerate
27 to go up the hill; and

28
29 WHEREAS, while the Honolulu Board of Water Supply has
30 attested that the traffic loading from a public bus should not
31 have any adverse impacts to the existing water mains based on



1 the current depths of their installation, and according to
2 information provided, twelve of the thirteen incidents were due
3 to unknown causes or had "no cause recorded", despite the fair
4 to good conditions of each of the pipes; and

5
6 WHEREAS, the Honolulu Board of Water Supply has no current
7 plans to replace the pipe at Makau Street as they have
8 reprioritized their budget to focus on pipeline replacement
9 projects for the Aiea and Halawa areas following the
10 contamination crisis at the Red Hill Bulk Fuel Storage Facility;
11 and

12
13 WHEREAS, rerouting the turnaround point for the Route C and
14 Route 93 to the Keeau Beach Park parking lot could serve as a
15 more functional, safe, and appropriate location by using open
16 space public lands as opposed to a narrow road used for beach
17 access by pedestrians; and

18
19 WHEREAS, in its current form, the Keeau Beach Park parking
20 lot is too narrow to accommodate the Route C and Route 93 as a
21 turnaround point; now, therefore,

22
23 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-second
24 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2023, the
25 House of Representatives concurring, that the City and County of
26 Honolulu is requested to relocate the bus turnaround off Makau
27 Street to Keaau Beach Park or the surrounding area; and

29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
30 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Director of
31 Transportation; Mayor of the City and County of Honolulu;
32 Director of Transportation Services of the City and County of
33 Honolulu; Director of Parks and Recreation of the City and
34 County of Honolulu; and President and General Manager of Oahu
35 Transit Services, Inc.
