## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU TO EXEMPT FROM REAL PROPERTY TAX THOSE PROPERTY OWNERS OF RESIDENTIAL UNITS WITHIN ONE-HALF MILE OF AN ACTIVE MUNICIPAL SOLID WASTE LANDFILL OR CONSTRUCTION AND DEMOLITION LANDFILL.

WHEREAS, every community in Hawaii deserves a "clean and 1 healthful environment" pursuant to article XI, section 9, of the 2 3 Hawaii State Constitution; and 4 WHEREAS, the scientific consensus is that landfills 5 generally -- and construction and demolition landfills 6 7 specifically -- have negative health impacts for those who live, 8 work, and play in close proximity; and 9 WHEREAS, Act 73, Session Laws of Hawaii 2020, established 10 Hawaii's statewide buffer zone law, which prohibits any waste or 11 12 disposal facility from being located in a conservation district except in emergency circumstances and prohibits persons, 13 14 including the State or any county, from constructing, operating, 15 modifying, expanding, or closing a municipal solid waste landfill or construction and demolition landfill without first 16 establishing a buffer zone of no less than one-half mile; and 17 18 WHEREAS, the 2008 Hawaii Environmental Justice Initiative 19 20 Report's definition of "environmental justice" for Hawaii recognized that "no one segment of the population or geographic 21 22 area should be disproportionately burdened with environmental 23 and/or health impacts resulting from development, construction, operations and/or use of natural resources"; and 24 25 26 WHEREAS, residents within one-half mile of an active operation of municipal solid waste landfills or construction and 27 demolition landfills are disproportionately burdened generally; 28 29 and 30

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WHEREAS, for example, according to Centers for Disease 1 Control and Prevention data, residents in the two census tracts 2 abutting PVT Land Company LTD.'s landfill in Nanakuli, Oahu, à 3 predominantly Native Hawaiian community, live ten years less 4 5 than the state average of eighty-two years and have the second and third lowest life expectancies in the entire State; and 6 7 8 WHEREAS, Act 73, Session Laws of Hawaii 2020, addressed only future operations of waste and disposal facilities and did 9 not address the safety and health of those residents suffering 10 from the active operation of existing facilities; and 11 12 13 WHEREAS, those living within a one-half mile of an active municipal solid waste landfill or a construction and demolition 14 15 landfill would benefit from funds made available from a property tax exemption to address their individual safety and health; 16 17 now, therefore, 18 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-second 19 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2023, the 20 House of Representatives concurring, that the City and County of 21 Honolulu is urged to exempt from real property tax those 22 property owners of residential units within one-half mile of an 23 active municipal solid waste landfill or construction and 24 demolition landfill; and 25 26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 27 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Governor, Mayor of 28 the City and County of Honolulu, and each member of the Honolulu 29 City Council. 30 31 32 33 OFFERED BY:

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
