SENATE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE COUNTIES TO UPDATE THE DESIGN AND FORMAT OF VEHICLE REGISTRATION PLATES IN RESPONSE TO GROWING ELECTRIC VEHICLE AND HYBRID VEHICLE SALES.

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the State to 1 2 effectively manage the distribution and circulation of vehicle registration plates, also known as license plates or number 3 plates, especially as consumer trends in the automotive industry 4 rapidly change; and 5 6 WHEREAS, Hawaii's rainbow license plate design is nearing 7 the end of its current numbering pattern and will need to 8 change; and 9 10 WHEREAS, the people of the State are seeking alternatives 11 to qasoline-powered vehicles as qasoline prices rise and harmful 12 emissions continue to warm our climate; and 13 14 WHEREAS, hybrid vehicle sales have been increasing as 15 consumers view these vehicles as a convenient middle ground 16 between conventional gasoline-powered vehicles and electric 17 vehicles; and 18 19 WHEREAS, electric vehicle adoption is growing 20 exponentially, with many major car manufacturers phasing out 21 gasoline-powered cars completely by 2035; and 22 23 WHEREAS, as a result, Hawaii's temporary electric vehicle 24 license plate numbering scheme needs to be changed to keep up 25 with this demand; and 26 27 WHEREAS, electric vehicle license plates in the State 28 29 currently use four characters, three of which are numbers and one of which is a letter; and 30 31 WHEREAS, at the current pace of electric vehicle sales, the 32 33 current alphanumeric scheme will last for only five years; and 34

1	WHEREAS, updating the present license plate schemes is	
2	necessary to accommodate shifting trends for electric, hybrid,	
3	and gasoline-powered vehicle sales in the State; now, therefore,

5	BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-second	
6	Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2023,	
7	that the counties are requested to update the design and format	
8	of vehicle registration plates in response to the growing	
9	electric vehicle and hybrid vehicle sales; and

11	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that beginning January 1, 2025, that	
12	the Director of Finance of each county is requested to issue	
13	number plates in the following manner:	
14	(7)	Number of the first of a solid line about the
15	(1)	Number plates for electric vehicles should bear the
16 17		word "Hawaii" along the upper portion of the plate and the words "Aloha State" along the lower portion of the
17 18		plate and contain a colorful design reflecting the
10 19		State's unique environment;
20		state s'unique environment,
20	(2)	Number plates for hybrid vehicles should bear the word
22	(2)	"Hawaii" on the upper portion of the plate and the
23		words "hybrid vehicle" on any portion of the plate and
24		use the rainbow design featured on number plates,
25		except special number plates, issued in the State
26		beginning in 1991; and
27		
28	(3)	Number plates for gasoline-powered vehicles should
29		bear the word "Hawaii" along the upper portion of the
30		plate and the words "gas vehicle" on any portion of
31		the plate and use the rainbow design featured on
32		number plates, except special number plates, issued in
33		the State beginning in 1991; and

35	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this	
36 37	Resolution be transmitted to the mayors of each county and the directors of finance of each county.
