SENATE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO EVALUATE CERTAIN
AIEA ROADWAYS AND IDENTIFY OPPORTUNITIES FOR IMPROVEMENT OF
TRAFFIC CONDITIONS AND PEDESTRIAN SAFETY.

1 WHEREAS, drivers who perform illegal U-turns endanger
2 oncoming traffic and pedestrian safety; and
3

4 WHEREAS, illegal U-turns occur at the intersection of
5 Moanalua Road and Kaimakani Street by drivers travelling
6 eastbound on Moanalua Road who wish to travel westbound on the
7 same road; and

9 WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation's mission
10 includes providing a safe transportation system that ensures the
11 mobility of people and enhances or preserves quality of life;
12 now, therefore,
13

14 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-second
15 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2023,
16 that the Department of Transportation is requested to evaluate
17 traffic at the:
18

19 (1) Intersection of Moanalua Road and Kaimakani Street;
20 and

22 (2) Westbound transition and exit for Highway 99; and

24 identify opportunities for improvement of traffic conditions and
25 pedestrian safety, in particular the enforcement of illegal U-
26 turns; and

28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of
29 Transportation is requested to submit a report of its findings
30 and recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the
31 Legislature no later than December 31, 2023; and
