Your Committee on Health & Homelessness, to which was referred S.C.R. No. 112 entitled:

"SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE HAWAII STATE CENTER FOR NURSING TO CONVENE A WORKING GROUP TO STUDY THE FEASIBILITY AND IMPACT OF THE STATE ADOPTING THE NURSE LICENSURE COMPACT,"

The purpose of this measure is to request the Hawaii State Center for Nursing to convene a working group to study the feasibility and impact of the state adopting the nurse licensure compact.
