RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLE INSPECTIONS.  
Provides that no new vehicle needs a safety inspection until five  
years after the date the vehicle was first sold, unless the vehicle  
was modified. Requires a two-year motor vehicle safety check  
for vehicles ten years of age or newer, unless the vehicle was  
modified. Requires an annual motor vehicle safety check for  
vehicles older than ten years of age or any vehicle that has been  
modified. Doubles the inspection fee for the two-year motor  
vehicles inspection safety check.
