RELATING TO THE AFFORDABLE HOMEOWNERSHIP REVOLVING FUND.

HHFDC <u>strongly supports</u> H.B. 992, a bill that would ensure that the \$5,000,000 previously appropriated under Act 248, SLH 2022, to seed the Affordable Homeownership Revolving Fund (AHRF) established under Act 227, SLH 2021, will revolve back into AHRF as program loans are repaid.

Under the current language in Act 248, SLH 2022, loan repayments would be made to the General Fund, instead of the AHRF. This bill's technical amendment would allow the \$5,000,000 in General Funds to be deposited into AHRF and then expended out of AHRF, allowing monies to revolve back into AHRF as intended.

The Department of Business, Economic Development and Tourism (DBEDT) **strongly supports** HB992, an Administration bill that clarifies that the \$5,000,000 in general funds that was appropriated in Act 248, SLH 2022 (the supplemental budget), for the purpose of providing, in whole or in part, loans to nonprofit community development financial institutions and nonprofit housing development organizations for the development of affordable homeownership housing projects, is to be deposited into and expended from the Affordable Homeownership Revolving Fund, for which the revolving fund was established.
