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**A BILL FOR AN ACT**

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE  
THIRTY-SECOND REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue  
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$20,200,000 or so much  
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof  
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2023-2024  
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the thirty-  
6 second representative district, as follows:

- 7 1. Aiea elementary school, Oahu  
8 Design, construction, and equipment and  
9 appurtenances for installation of an  
10 elevator and construction of second  
11 floor connecting walkways for buildings  
12 A, B and C. The elevated walkways will  
13 also serve as a covering for the first  
14 floor walkways connecting these  
15 buildings.

1           The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project  
2 shall be expended by the department of education.

3           SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital  
4 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at  
5 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;  
6 provided that all moneys from the appropriation unencumbered as  
7 of June 30, 2026, shall lapse as of that date.

8           SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2023.
