
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO DRIVING WITHOUT A LICENSE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. This Act shall be known as "Sara's Law".

2 SECTION 2. Section 286-136, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
3 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:

4 "(b) Any person who is convicted of violating section 286-
5 102, 286-122, 286-130, 286-131, 286-132, 286-133, or 286-134
6 shall be subject to a minimum fine of \$500 and a maximum fine of
7 \$1,000, or imprisoned no more than one year, or both, if the
8 person has two or more prior convictions for the same offense in
9 the preceding five-year period~~[+]~~; provided that upon a third
10 conviction for the same offense within five years, the vehicle
11 owned and used by the defendant in the commission of the third
12 offense may be ordered by the court to be subject to forfeiture
13 under chapter 712A."

14 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
15 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.



1 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.
