
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$120,000,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2024-2025
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the
6 University of Hawaii at Manoa, as follows:

7 1. Repair, improve, and modernization
8 projects for student housing
9 Construction for Hale Wainani plumbing
10 replacement, fire alarm replacement and
11 sprinkler assessment, Frear Hall roof
12 replacement, and Wainani low rise roof
13 replacement.

14	Construction	\$40,000,000
15	Total funding	\$40,000,000

2 shall be expended by the University of Hawaii.

3 2. Hale Noelani renovation

4 Equipment and appurtenances for
5 renovation for the livability of the
6 five Noelani buildings.

8 Total funding \$80,000,000


9 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
10 shall be expended by the University of Hawaii.

11 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
12 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
13 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;
14 provided that all moneys from the appropriation unencumbered as
15 of June 30, 2026, shall lapse as of that date.

16 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2024.
