
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE SEVENTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$133,527,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2024-2025
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the seventh
6 representative district, as follows:

7 1. Ellison Onizuka Kona International
8 Airport livestock inspections
9 Plans, design, construction, and
10 equipment and appurtenances for
11 inspection of livestock arriving and
12 departing from the Ellison Onizuka Kona
13 International Airport.

19 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
20 shall be expended by the university of Hawaii.



1 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
2 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
3 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;
4 provided that all moneys from the appropriation unencumbered as
5 of June 30, 2026, shall lapse as of that date.

6 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2024.
