# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AGRICULTURE.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 149A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated  
3 and to read as follows:

4 "§149A- Pesticide inspection program; restricted use

5 pesticides; banned pesticides. (a) The department shall

6 establish and implement a pesticide inspection program to:

7 (1) Increase compliance with proper use of restricted use

8 pesticides; and

9 (2) Ensure the continued prohibition on the use or

10 application of pesticides containing chlorpyrifos

11 pursuant to section 149A-31(7).

12 (b) In establishing the pesticide inspection program, the

13 department shall:

14 (1) Develop a system to conduct inspections annually or in

15 response to a complaint to determine if any violations

16 of section 149A-31(3), (4), or (7) were committed; and



1       (2) Develop an online reporting tool for restricted use  
2               pesticides, with the data available to the public.

3       (c) The department shall post the results of all pesticide  
4 inspections conducted pursuant to this section on the  
5 department's website and update the results upon completion of  
6 each inspection.

7       (d) The department shall adopt rules pursuant to chapter  
8 91 necessary for the implementation of this section."

9       SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

10       SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.



**Report Title:**

Department of Agriculture; Pesticide Inspection Program;

Requires the Department of Agriculture to establish and implement a pesticide inspection program to increase compliance with the proper use of restricted use pesticides by agricultural producers and ensure the continued prohibition on the use of chlorpyrifos. Effective 7/1/3000. (SD1)
