
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
FORTY-FOURTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$56,810,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2024-2025
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the forty-
6 fourth representative district, as follows:

7 1. Kapolei high school

8 Design and construction for the
9 installation of field turf for softball
10 and baseball athletic fields.

11 Design \$500,000

12 Construction \$7,500,000

13 Total funding \$8,000,000

14 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
15 shall be expended by the department of education.

16 2. Nānākuli elementary school



1 Construction for the renovation of
2 staff bathrooms in B building and C
3 building, both upstairs and downstairs.

4 Construction \$200,000

5 Total funding \$200,000

6 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
7 shall be expended by the department of education.

8 3. Nānākuli elementary school

9 Construction for the resurfacing of the
10 front parking lot.

11 Construction \$750,000

12 Total funding \$750,000

13 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
14 shall be expended by the department of education.

15 4. Nānākuli elementary school

16 Construction for the resurfacing of the
17 hillside at back of the basketball
18 courts.

19 Construction \$350,000

20 Total funding \$350,000



1 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
2 shall be expended by the department of education.

3 5. Nānākuli elementary school

4 Equipment and appurtenances for the
5 replacement of vandalized cameras with
6 new and higher quality cameras.

7 Equipment \$50,000

8 Total funding \$50,000

9 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
10 shall be expended by the department of education.

11 6. Nānākuli elementary school

12 Equipment and appurtenances for the
13 upper field and installation of a
14 sprinkler system.

15 Equipment \$500,000

16 Total funding \$500,000

17 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
18 shall be expended by the department of education.

19 7. Nānākuli high and intermediate school

20 Design, construction, and equipment,
21 and appurtenances for a performing arts



1 center at Nānākuli high and
2 intermediate school.

3 Design \$5,000,000
4 Construction \$34,000,000
5 Equipment \$1,000,000

6 Total funding \$40,000,000

7 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
8 shall be expended by the department of education.

9 8. Ka Waihona o ka Na'auao public charter
10 school

11 Construction for an emergency access
12 road for emergency and safety purposes.

13 Construction \$200,000

14 Total funding \$200,000

15 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
16 shall be expended by the state public charter school commission.

17 9. Ka Waihona o ka Na'auao public charter
18 school

19 Construction for protective covering
20 for outdoor sports areas and classroom



1 spaces to create additional instruction
2 areas for students.

3 Construction \$150,000

4 Total funding \$150,000

5 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
6 shall be expended by the state public charter school commission.

7 10. Ka Waihona o ka Na'auao public charter
8 school

9 Construction for repairs and
10 maintenance of buildings and structures
11 on school site.

12 Construction \$5,000,000

13 Total funding \$5,000,000

14 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
15 shall be expended by the state public charter school commission.

16 11. Ka Waihona o ka Na'auao public charter
17 school

18 Construction for roofs repairs for
19 approximately twenty-three buildings.

20 Construction \$1,610,000

21 Total funding \$1,610,000




1 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
2 shall be expended by the state public charter school commission.

3 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
4 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
5 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;
6 provided that all moneys from the appropriation unencumbered as
7 of June 30, 2026, shall lapse as of that date.

8 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2024.
