
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. There is appropriated out of the general
2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and the
4 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
5 2024-2025 for the operation of mobile clinics providing
6 medication-assisted treatment throughout the State; provided
7 that the mobile clinics shall be staffed with medical
8 professionals, including behavioral therapists trained in
9 cognitive-behavioral and contingency management interventions.

10 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
11 of human services for the purposes of this Act.

12 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2023.
