
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU TO ESTABLISH A NEW
SATELLITE CITY HALL OFFICE IN MILILANI TO IMPROVE ACCESS TO
GOVERNMENT SERVICES.

1 WHEREAS, according to the latest United States Census
2 Bureau data, Hawaii has the seventh highest percentage of senior
3 residents in the nation; and

4
5 WHEREAS, residents aged sixty-five and older account for
6 25.4 per cent of the Mililani Town's population and 10.4 per
7 cent of the Mililani Mauka's population; and

8
9 WHEREAS, the City and County of Honolulu has nine satellite
10 city hall offices across Oahu; and

11
12 WHEREAS, the satellite city hall offices serve communities
13 by offering various services, including motor vehicle
14 registration, disability parking permit, state identification
15 renewal, and property tax payment; and

17 WHEREAS, due to the lack of a satellite city hall in
18 Mililani, local residents need to travel outside their community
19 to access essential government services, which may be
20 challenging for the elderly population; now, therefore,

22 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
23 Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular
24 Session of 2024, the Senate concurring, that the City and County
25 of Honolulu is urged to establish a new satellite city hall
26 office in Mililani to bring government services closer to local
27 residents; and

29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the City and County of Honolulu and
30 the Honolulu City Council are requested to support additional

1 funding and resources to create the Mililani satellite city
2 hall; and

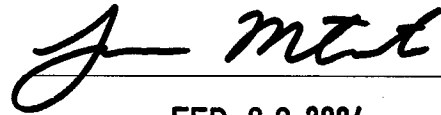
4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
