
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU TO CONDUCT A SIDEWALK
FEASIBILITY STUDY ALONG KALIHI STREET FROM KAMANAIKI STREET
TO KALIHI VALLEY PARK.

1 WHEREAS, since the advent of the concept of complete
2 streets, Honolulu has embarked on many projects to enhance
3 pedestrian safety, convenience, and accessibility; and
4

5 WHEREAS, Kalihi Valley is an older community, most of it
6 built before modern standards for road construction were
7 developed; and
8

9 WHEREAS, Kalihi Street is the main artery through Kalihi
10 Valley stretching from North School Street to Kalihi Valley Park
11 at the end of the valley, with many feeder roads in between; and
12

13 WHEREAS, most of the upper portion of Kalihi Street has no
14 sidewalks at all resulting in many dangerous locations along the
15 street, particularly for the disabled and kupuna, who are unable
16 to traverse certain places along the street without walking onto
17 the street itself; now, therefore,

19 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
20 Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular
21 Session of 2024, the Senate concurring, that the City and County
22 of Honolulu is requested to conduct a sidewalk feasibility study
23 between Kamanaiki Street and Kalihi Valley Park to address major
24 concerns and deficiencies along Kalihi Street; and

26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the sidewalk feasibility study
27 focus specifically on removing telephone poles along the section
28 of Kalihi Street between Kamanaiki Street and Kalihi Valley Park
29 and, instead, placing electrical and telecommunications wires
30 underground; and




