
HOUSE RESOLUTION

URGING THE COUNTIES TO ADOPT AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING RESTAURANTS AND OTHER FOOD SERVICE ESTABLISHMENTS TO TAKE STEPS TO MAKE THEIR BUSINESSES SAFE FOR MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC WITH SEVERE FOOD ALLERGIES.

1 WHEREAS, according to studies conducted by the National
2 Center for Health Statistics using data from the 2021 National
3 Health Interview Survey, nearly one-third of adults aged
4 eighteen and over in the United States had a seasonal allergy,
5 eczema, or food allergy, and a little over one-quarter of
6 children in the United States had at least one allergic
7 condition; and

9 WHEREAS, according to the Asthma and Allergy Foundation of
10 America, allergies are the sixth leading cause of illness, and
11 each year approximately ninety thousand emergency room visits
12 are the result of anaphylaxis; and

14 WHEREAS, anaphylaxis is a rapid onset, potentially life-
15 threatening systemic allergic reaction that can affect people of
16 any age or gender; and

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18 WHEREAS, according to the Center for Disease Control and
19 Prevention, allergies are responsible for between one hundred
20 fifty and two hundred deaths each year, over half of which are
21 caused by food from a restaurant or other food service
22 establishment; and

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24 WHEREAS, under existing state law, the counties are
25 empowered to enact ordinances deemed necessary to protect
26 health, life, and property and to preserve the order and
27 security of the county and its inhabitants on any subject or
28 matter not inconsistent with, or tending to defeat, the intent
29 of any state statute; now, therefore,

1 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
 2 Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular
 3 Session of 2024, that the counties are urged to adopt an
 4 ordinance requiring restaurants and other food service
 5 establishments to take steps to make their businesses safe for
 6 members of the public with severe food allergies; and

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 8 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the county ordinance is
 9 requested to include a requirement that restaurants and other
 10 food service establishments:

 12 (1) Prominently display a food allergy awareness poster in
 13 the staff area, which shall include information on the
 14 risks of an allergic reaction;
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 16 (2) Include on their menu, or on a menu insert, language
 17 requesting customers to inform their server about any
 18 food allergies; and

 20 (3) Make available to the public a master list of all
 21 ingredients used in the preparation of each food item
 22 available for consumption; and

24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the counties are requested to
 25 work with the Department of Human Nutrition, Food, and Animal
 26 Sciences at the University of Hawaii and Hawaii Restaurant
 27 Association to develop the food allergy awareness poster; and

29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
 30 Resolution be transmitted to the Mayors of the Counties of Maui,
 31 Kauai, and Hawaii; Mayor of the City and County of Honolulu;
 32 Chairs of the County Councils of the Counties of Maui, Kauai,
 33 and Hawaii; and Council Chair of the City and County of
 34 Honolulu.
