
HOUSE RESOLUTION

URGING THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU TO WORK WITH STAKEHOLDERS
TO CONSTRUCT A SIDEWALK FOR PEDESTRIAN SAFETY WHILE
TRAVELING BETWEEN IROQUOIS POINTE AND EWA BEACH.

1 WHEREAS, the safety of pedestrians traveling from Iroquois
2 Pointe to Ewa Beach is of paramount importance; and
3

4 WHEREAS, the State Department of Transportation has
5 recognized the importance of available sidewalks by identifying
6 pedestrians and bicyclists as the most vulnerable roadway users;
7 and

9 WHEREAS, the lack of adequate lighting, presence of dense
10 bushes, and absence of sidewalks pose a significant risk of
11 accidents and jeopardize the safety of individuals in transit
12 between Iroquois Pointe and Ewa Beach; and

14 WHEREAS, it is imperative to address this safety concern
15 promptly to prevent potential accidents and protect lives; and

17 WHEREAS, the region between Iroquois Pointe and Ewa Beach
18 interests many stakeholders including private property owners,
19 the United States Navy, the City and County of Honolulu, and the
20 Ewa Beach Golf Course; now, therefore,

22 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
23 Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular
24 Session of 2024, that the City and County of Honolulu is urged
25 to work with stakeholders to construct a sidewalk for pedestrian
26 safety while traveling between Iroquois Pointe and Ewa Beach;

30 Resolution be transmitted to the Mayor of the City and County of
31 Honolulu, the Chairperson of the Honolulu City Council, and the
