## HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU, COUNTY OF MAUI, AND COUNTY OF KAUAI PASS ORDINANCES SIMILAR TO THE COUNTY OF HAWAII'S BILL 82 (2023-2024) RELATING TO IMPROVING PRIVATE ROADS.

1           WHEREAS, there are many private, nondedicated and non-  
2 surrendered roads throughout the State of Hawaii that are open  
3 to and utilized by the general public; and

4  
5           WHEREAS, section 265A-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, grants  
6 the several counties the power, by ordinance, to improve, grade,  
7 repair, or do any construction upon private streets; and

8  
9           WHEREAS, the owners of private roads often do not have the  
10 resources to improve or correct deficiencies on these roads; and

11  
12           WHEREAS, while the counties have different policies  
13 relating to private roads, generally they will not unilaterally  
14 repair or upkeep private roads to county standards; and

15  
16           WHEREAS, the public interest is served by the counties  
17 performing improvements to private roads that are used by the  
18 public; and

20           WHEREAS, the County of Hawaii has passed into law Bill 82  
21 (2023-2024) authorizing the county to improve, grade, repair or  
22 do construction work upon private, nondedicated, and non-  
23 surrendered roads; now, therefore,

25           BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the  
26 Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular  
27 Session of 2024, that the county councils of Honolulu, Maui, and  
28 Kauai consider passing an ordinance similar to the County of  
29 Hawaii's Bill 82 (2023-2024) relating to improving private  
30 roads; and


