A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SPEEDING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 291C-104, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:

3 "(c) Any person who violates this section shall be fined
4 \$250 [7] i; may be charged with a surcharge of up to \$100 to be
5 deposited into the trauma system special fund [7] i; and, where the
6 violation involves speeding in a school zone, shall be charged
7 with a surcharge of \$25 to be deposited into the safe routes to
8 school program special fund [-] and shall be subject to the
9 following:

10 (1) For the first offense, an additional fine of \$250;

11 (2) For the second offense, an additional fine of \$500;

12 and

13 (3) For the third or subsequent offense occurring within
14 eighteen months of a first offense:

15 (A) An additional fine of \$1000; and

16 (B) Revocation of license and privilege to operate a
17 vehicle for a period of one year."
