A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to establish a
2 three-year pilot program to examine signalized intersections
3 with crosswalks, walk signals, and motor vehicle traffic.

4 SECTION 2. (a) There is established a three-year pilot
5 program within the department of transportation, in
6 collaboration with counties, to examine signalized intersections
7 that are programmed to allow crosswalk and pedestrian movement
8 signs to commence four seconds before the green light is given
9 to motor vehicle traffic when the walk button has been pressed.

10 (b) The department of transportation shall submit a report
11 of its findings and recommendations, including any proposed
12 legislation, to the legislature no later than twenty days prior
13 to the convening of the regular session of 2027.

14 SECTION 3. In accordance with section 9 of article VII of
15 the Hawaii State Constitution and sections 37-91 and 37-93,
16 Hawaii Revised Statutes, the legislature has determined that the
17 appropriations contained in Act 164, Regular Session of 2023,

Report Title:

DOT; Traffic Control; Intersections; Pilot Program; Expenditure Ceiling; Appropriation

Description:

Establishes a three-year pilot program within the Department of Transportation, in collaboration with the counties, to examine signalized intersections that are programmed to all crosswalk and pedestrian movement signs to commence four seconds before the green light is given to motor vehicle traffic when the walk button has been presses. Requires a report to the Legislature. Declares that the general fund expenditure ceiling is exceeded. Makes an appropriation.

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
