A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII ADMINISTRATIVE RULES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. (a) There is established within the department
2 of the attorney general for administrative purposes a blue
3 ribbon committee to analyze and examine the Hawaii
4 administrative rules and identify any rules that are not
5 supported by the Hawaii Revised Statutes.

6 (b) The blue ribbon committee shall consist of the
7 following members:

8 (1) Two individuals who shall be invited to participate by
9 the president of the senate;

10 (2) Two individuals who shall be invited to participate by
11 the speaker of the house of representatives; and

12 (3) One individual who shall be invited to participate by
13 the director of the legislative reference bureau.

14 The members of the blue ribbon committee shall serve
15 without compensation but shall be reimbursed for reasonable
16 expenses necessary for the performance of their duties,
17 including travel expenses.




1 (c) The blue ribbon committee shall submit a report of its
2 findings and recommendations, including any proposed
3 legislation, to the legislature no later than twenty days prior
4 to the convening of the regular session of 2025.

5 (d) The blue ribbon committee shall be dissolved upon
6 adjournment sine die of the regular session of 2025.

7 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
