
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the performance of
2 work by university employees is a matter of statewide concern
3 pursuant to article X, section 6, of the Hawaii State
4 Constitution.

5 SECTION 2. Chapter 304A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
6 amended by adding a new section to part III to be appropriately
7 designated and to read as follows:

8 "§304A- Annual report; employees working outside of the
9 State. No later than December 31 of each year, the university
10 shall submit an annual report to the legislature of all
11 university employees who performed work from a location outside
12 of the State during the applicable year. The report shall
13 include, for each employee who performed work from a location
14 outside of the State, the position, position description, salary
15 range, and duration of time spent performing work from a
16 location outside of the State."

17 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
