A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
ELEVENTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$10,620,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2024-2025
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the eleventh
6 senatorial district, as follows:

7 1. Lincoln Elementary School

8 A. Design and construction for
9 electrical infrastructure upgrades
10 to increase electrical capacity
11 across the campus.

15 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
 16 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
 17 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is
 18 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation
 19 unencumbered as of June 30, 2026, shall lapse as of that date.

20 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
 21 capital improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be



1 expended for the purpose of this Act by the department of
2 education.

3 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2024.
