A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CURRENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 481B, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately
3 designated and to read as follows:


4 "§481B- Forms of payment; cash. (a) All merchants
5 shall accept cash as payment for goods or services; provided
6 that this section shall not apply to online purchases or sales
7 made over the Internet.

8 (b) As used in this section, "merchant" shall have the
9 same meaning as in section 481B-5.5."

10 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
11 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

12 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
