# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO REUSABLES.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. (a) There is established within the department  
2 of health, a three-year pilot program to be known as the  
3 upcycled mobile dishwashing system pilot program to create a  
4 circular reuse dishwashing system within the Kohala district.  
5 The pilot program shall utilize an upcycled shipping container  
6 that can be placed on county or state property, using existing  
7 renewable energy and water infrastructure.

8           (b) The department of health shall establish the following  
9 two full-time equivalent positions (2.0 FTE):

10           (1) A committee-appointed consultant position that shall  
11 work with the department to manage and implement the  
12 upcycled mobile dishwashing system pilot program,  
13 including ensuring best practices are utilized for the  
14 oversight of the program; and

15           (2) A developer to design a reusable certification  
16 program, including a permitting process, and methods  
17 for collection, sanitization, and redistribution of



1           preapproved containers according to standards adopted  
2           for the program.

3           (c) The department of health shall submit a report of its  
4 findings and recommendations, including any proposed  
5 legislation, to the legislature no later than twenty days prior  
6 to the convening of the Regular Session of 2027.

7           SECTION 2. In accordance with section 9 of article VII of  
8 the Hawaii State Constitution and sections 37-91 and 37-93,  
9 Hawaii Revised Statutes, the legislature has determined that the  
10 appropriations contained in Act 164, Regular Session of 2023,  
11 and this Act will cause the state general fund expenditure  
12 ceiling for fiscal year 2024-2025 to be exceeded by  
13 \$           or           per cent. This current declaration takes  
14 into account general fund appropriations authorized for fiscal  
15 year 2024-2025 in Act 164, Regular Session of 2023, and this Act  
16 only. The reasons for exceeding the general fund expenditure  
17 ceiling are that:

- 18           (1) The appropriation made in this Act is necessary to  
19           serve the public interest; and  
20           (2) The appropriation made in this Act meets the needs  
21           addressed by this Act.



1 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general  
2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$405,573 or so much  
3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2024-2025 to:

4 (1) Create and implement the upcycled mobile dishwashing  
5 system pilot program; and

6 (2) Establish one full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE)  
7 consultant position and one full-time equivalent (1.0  
8 FTE) developer position within the department of  
9 health for the pilot program.

10 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
11 health for the purposes of this Act.

12 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2024.

**Report Title:**

DOH; Upcycled Mobile Dishwashing System; Pilot Program; Report; Expenditure Ceiling; Appropriation

Establishes the Upcycled Mobile Dishwashing System Pilot Program within the Department of Health. Requires a report to the Legislature. Establishes two full-time positions within the Department of Health. Declares the general fund expenditure ceiling is exceeded. Makes an appropriation.
