
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO COMPLIANCE ON HAWAIIAN HOME LANDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that illegal activity
2 occurring on Hawaiian home lands threatens the health and safety
3 of the community. Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to
4 appropriate funds to the department of law enforcement to hire
5 law enforcement officers dedicated to investigating complaints,
6 conducting investigations, and cooperating with enforcement
7 authorities to ensure compliance with state laws and rules,
8 county ordinances, including the Hawaiian Homes Commission Act,
9 1920, as amended, and the rules adopted thereunder, on Hawaiian
10 home lands.

11 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
12 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
13 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and
14 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
15 year 2024-2025 for the department of law enforcement to
16 hire full-time equivalent (.0 FTE) law enforcement
17 officers dedicated to the Hawaiian home lands.



1 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
2 of law enforcement for the purposes of this Act.

3 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2023.
