SENATE RESOLUTION

URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION AND HAWAI'I EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY TO ADOPT A CURRICULUM FOR HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS TO PARTICIPATE IN THE YOUTH CIVIL DEFENSE CORPS.

WHEREAS, the Hawai'i Emergency Management Agency (HI-EMA) 1 serves as the official emergency management agency for the State 2 and is the primary coordinating agency between the State and 3 each county emergency management agencies; and 4 5 WHEREAS, as established under chapter 127A, Hawaii Revised 6 7 Statutes, HI-EMA's primary role is to maintain a comprehensive, coordinated, and cooperative emergency management program that 8 9 prepares for, mitigates against, responds to, and recovers from emergencies and disasters that threaten or impact the State; and 10 11 12 WHEREAS, to effectively complete this broad mandate, HI-EMA must establish a shared framework for the coordination of 13 response and recovery actions, including the organization of 14 15 state agencies, private sector entities, local communities, and civilians; and 16 17 18 WHEREAS, during emergencies and disasters, pre-trained 19 volunteers can fill the need for additional emergency personnel; 20 and 21 22 WHEREAS, a youth civil defense corps, to be established by 23 the Department of Education can enable HI-EMA to effectively lead statewide emergency management efforts; and 24 25 26 WHEREAS, by training high school students through a civil 27 defense program, the Department of Education can further hazard mitigation and recovery plan implementation in the event of an 28 29 emergency or disaster; now, therefore, 30 31 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2024, 32 that the Department of Education, in consultation with the 33 Hawai'i Emergency Management Agency, is requested to establish a 34 35 Youth Civil Defense Corps; and
