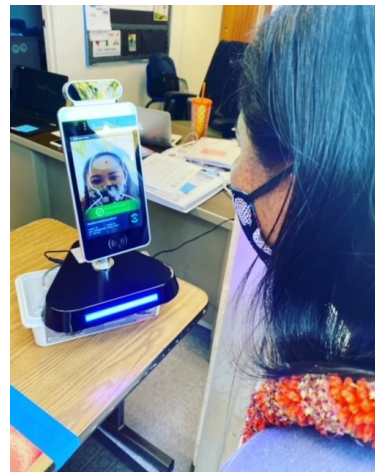

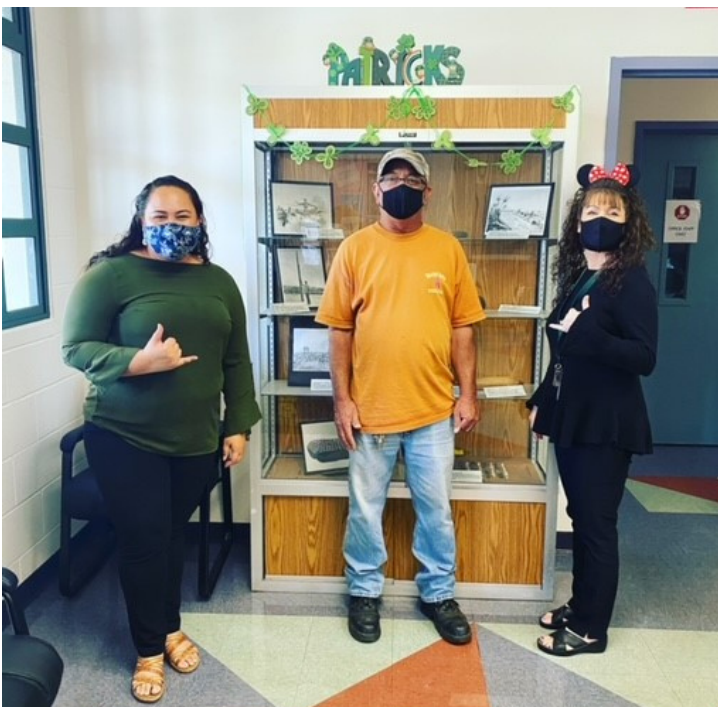
Visiting With School Principals
