Traffic Safety in Our Community

The incident involving the McKinley High School student at the Kapi'olani-Kamake'e Street intersection was tragic and further reinforced the need to improve our roads to protect pedestrians and responsible drivers. Last week, we announced the following safety improvements:

1. The state will install elevated or modified crosswalks at Kamake'e Street and on Pensacola Street (between King St. and Kapi'olani Blvd) within 30 days;
2. The state will install a red light camera at the Kapi'olani-Kamake'e Street intersection within 30 days; and
3. The city will begin an engineering study to implement left turn signals at the Kapi'olani-Kamake'e Street intersection.
