My name is Randy Ho, and I am an Executive Officer of the Hawaii Medical Board (Board). The Board supports the confirmation of Mr. Wesley Mun's reappointment to the Board as a public member.

Mr. Mun was appointed to the Board in 2019 and has attended all but three meetings since his appointment. He retired in 2018 from a career in healthcare administration. Mr. Mun is a graduate of Iolani High School and the University of Hawaii (UH) at Manoa and completed his Master of Business Administration at UH Manoa in 1988.

Mr. Mun had an extensive career in healthcare administration. Earlier in his career, he was a clinic manager for Kaiser Foundation Hospitals, assistant administrator for Straub Clinic and Hospital Inc., vice president of operations for Hawaii Dental Service, and executive director for DentiCare of California and Hawaii. Since 1999, Mr. Mun worked for the State of Hawaii as the Corrections Health Care Division Administrator at the Public Safety Department and Med-Quest Division Administrator at the Department of Human Services. Mr. Mun enjoys skin diving and fishing, and volunteers in the community through the Rotary Club of Kahala Sunrise, Kung Sheong Doo Chinese Society, and United Self Help.

Since serving on the Board from 2019, Mr. Mun comes well prepared to all meetings, provides valuable healthcare administration input, and accurately applies statutes, administrative rules, and policies to all agenda matters. The Board believes
