## In consideration of HOUSE BILL 1886 HOUSE DRAFT 1 RELATING TO FIRE PROTECTION

House Bill 1886 House Draft 1 proposes authorizing the use of the Reduced Ignition Propensity Cigarette Program Special Fund to support the State Fire Council (Council) and its programs and activities, including hiring administrative personnel. The Department of Land and Natural Resources (Department) strongly supports this measure.

The Department's Division of Forestry and Wildlife (DOFAW) is the primary responder for wildland fires across 1,368,002 acres or about 26% of the land area of the State including forest and natural area reserves, wildlife sanctuaries, and public hunting areas, and supports federal and county responders on urban interface lands. DOFAW is a member of the Council and supports increased funding to the Council through the Fund for the Council staff to meet the increased demands upon the Council. The funds would provide for statewide educational efforts to protect life, property, and the environment, such as the statewide firefighter safety guide program for Hawai'i's youth and the residential smoke alarm installation program for Hawai'i's at-risk senior population.
