Aloha Chair Shimabukuro, Vice Chair Fevella, and members of the Committee:

The Department of Hawaiian Home Lands (DHHL) supports this bill which would 1) require the DHHL to complete an assessment and report of the feasibility of digitizing its applicant, beneficiary, and lessee records and creating an interactive digital database software program, 2) requires the DHHL to submit a report to the Legislature by 7/1/2025, and 3) makes an appropriation.

DHHL's Application Waitlists alphabetically or by island is available on DHHL's website. To modernize the DHHL information systems, DHHL is currently working with IT consultants to undertake an enterprise-wide system modernization project. The consultants and the DHHL are finalizing an implementation plan. Replacement of critical systems such as the Applicant/Lessee and Mortgage Loan system will be part of this modernization effort.

The estimated time frame is 2 to 4 years and will require intensive staff involvement. Additional staff is likely necessary to sufficiently maintain each module of the new system. IT staff is currently being hired to support the new systems. Staffing needs for other divisions specifically will be done as the new systems are designed and implemented.
