
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PRODUCT LABELING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 486, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to part V to be appropriately
3 designated and to read as follows:

4 "§486- Human cells; product labeling; requirements;
5 penalties. (a) No person doing business in the State shall
6 knowingly or intentionally expose any other person to a product
7 developed or tested using human cells unless the product bears a
8 warning label containing:

9 (1) A disclaimer that states that the product was
10 developed or tested using one or more human cells; and

11 (2) The address of a website disclosing:

12 (A) The origin of each human cell that was used to
13 develop or test the product was obtained;

14 (B) The method by which each human cell that was used
15 to develop or test the product was obtained; and

1 (C) The medical or scientific name, if any, of the
 2 human cell base line that was used to develop or
 3 test the product.

4 (b) Any person that fails to comply with the requirements
 5 of this section shall be subject to a fine in amount not to
 6 exceed \$ _____ or imprisonment for a period not to
 7 exceed _____, or both."

8 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
 9 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
 10 begun before its effective date.

11 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.

12 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
