
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE GENERATION OF WILDFIRE SUSCEPTIBILITY MAPS FOR HAWAII.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the development of
2 wildfire susceptibility and vulnerability maps for the State
3 will assist in emergency planning and preparation and is a
4 matter of statewide concern.

5 The purpose of this Act is to require the university of
6 Hawaii to generate wildfire susceptibility and vulnerability
7 maps.

8 SECTION 2. The university of Hawaii shall establish and
9 implement a two-year program to generate web-GIS wildfire
10 susceptibility and vulnerability maps for the State of Hawaii to
11 determine which communities, landscapes, buildings, and
12 infrastructure are most vulnerable to future wildfires.

13 The university of Hawaii shall submit a report of its
14 findings and recommendations, including any proposed
15 legislation, to the legislature no later than twenty days prior
16 to the convening of the regular session of 2026.



1 SECTION 3. In accordance with section 9 of article VII, of
2 the Constitution of the State of Hawaii and sections 37-91 and
3 37-93, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the legislature has determined
4 that the appropriation contained in this Act will cause the
5 state general fund expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2024-2025
6 to be exceeded by \$, or per cent. The reasons
7 for exceeding the general fund expenditure ceiling are that the
8 appropriation made in this Act is necessary to serve the public
9 interest and to meet the need provided for by this Act.

10 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general
11 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
12 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2024-2025 for
13 the development of wildfire susceptibility and vulnerability
14 maps for the State of Hawaii pursuant to this Act.

15 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the university of
16 Hawaii for the purposes of this Act; provided that the moneys
17 appropriated by this Act shall not lapse at the end of the
18 fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is made; provided
19 further that all moneys from the appropriation unencumbered on
20 June 30, 2026, shall lapse as of that date.



1 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.
