
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO NON-GENERAL FUNDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to repeal the hazard
2 mitigation special fund for the Hawaii emergency management
3 agency of the department of defense, pursuant to a
4 recommendation made by the auditor in auditor's report no.
5 23-16, and to transfer any unencumbered balance of the hazard
6 mitigation special fund to the general fund.

7 SECTION 2. Section 127A-18.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
8 repealed.


6 SECTION 3. Any unencumbered balance in the hazard
