A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR CLAIMS AGAINST THE STATE, ITS OFFICERS, OR ITS EMPLOYEES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	PART I
2	SECTION 1. In accordance with section 9 of article VII of
3	the Constitution of the State of Hawaii and sections 37-91 and
4	37-93, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the legislature has determined
5	that the general fund expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2023-
6	2024 has already been exceeded by \$1,005,342,735 or 9.4 per
7	cent. The appropriations contained in this Act will cause the
8	state general fund expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2023-2024
9	to be further exceeded by \$ or per cent. This
10	declaration takes into account the additional general fund
11	appropriation authorized for fiscal year 2023-2024 in this Act
12	only. The reasons for exceeding the general fund expenditure
13	ceiling are that:

- 1 SECTION 5. Notwithstanding the sums hereinabove stated as
- 2 interest upon judgments against the State, payment of interest
- 3 shall be limited to the period from the date of the judgment, if
- 4 applicable, to thirty days after the effective date of this Act,
- 5 as provided in section 662-8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, for those
- 6 cases to which the statute applies.
- 7 SECTION 6. All unexpended and unencumbered balances of the
- 8 appropriations made in this Act as of the close of business on
- 9 June 30, 2025, shall lapse.
- 10 SECTION 7. If any provision of this Act, or the
- 11 application thereof to any person or circumstance, is held
- 12 invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or
- 13 applications of the Act that can be given effect without the
- 14 invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions
- 15 of this Act are severable.
- 16 SECTION 8. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2024.
