
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PERMITS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 46, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
2 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to
3 read as follows:

4 "§46- County permit exemption; repetitive construction
5 projects. A contract for repetitive construction projects of
6 facilities under the control of the department of education,
7 University of Hawaii, or school facilities authority shall be
8 exempt from any applicable county permit requirement due to any
9 county agency having jurisdiction over the proposed action;
10 provided that no contract for repetitive construction projects
11 shall be exempt from federal, state, or county floodplain
12 management development standards or statutes, codes, ordinances,
13 rules, or regulations with which compliance is required under
14 the National Flood Insurance Program."

15 SECTION 2. Section 103-39.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
16 amended to read as follows:



1 "§103-39.5 Construction, renovation, or repair of school
2 facilities; county permit exemption. Any contract for the
3 construction, renovation, or repair of [~~public school~~]
4 facilities under the control of the department of education,
5 University of Hawaii, or school facilities authority shall be
6 exempt from any county requirement [~~of a county~~] that related
7 off-site improvements be made by the contracting government
8 agency as a condition to the issuance of any permit."

9 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
10 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

11 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on June 30, 3000.
