## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC EMPLOYERS.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Section 78-28, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended to read as follows:

3           "~~[+]§78-28[+]~~ **In-service training programs.** (a) Each  
4 director shall monitor, make recommendations, and develop  
5 policies and guidelines for suitable in-service training  
6 programs and activities so that the quality of service rendered  
7 by government employees may be continually improved.  
8 Participating agencies may be charged fees for training  
9 programs.

10           (b) Each employer shall provide to each employee of the  
11 employer cardiopulmonary resuscitation and defibrillator  
12 training.

13           (c) As used in this section, "employer" does not include  
14 the respective mayor of each county or any individual  
15 representing one of the mayors or acting in the interest of one  
16 of the mayors in dealing with public employees."



1 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general  
2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much  
3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and the  
4 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year  
5 2024-2025 for the provision of cardiopulmonary resuscitation  
6 training pursuant to this Act.

7 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the legislature  
8 for the purposes of this Act.

9 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general  
10 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much  
11 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and the  
12 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year  
13 2024-2025 for the provision of cardiopulmonary resuscitation  
14 training pursuant to this Act.

15 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the judiciary  
16 for the purposes of this Act.

17 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general  
18 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much  
19 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and the  
20 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year

1 2024-2025 for the provision of cardiopulmonary resuscitation  
2 training pursuant to this Act.


3 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department  
4 of human resources development for the purposes of this Act.
