
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE HAWAIIAN HOMES COMMISSION TO CONSULT BENEFICIARIES OF THE HAWAIIAN HOMES COMMISSION ACT REGARDING ALTERNATIVE WAITLIST AND AWARD PRIORITIZATION BASED ON LINEAL AND GENERATIONAL DESCENDANCY FOR HAWAIIAN HOME LANDS LOCATED IN HANA, MAUI.

1 WHEREAS, pursuant to section 101 of the Hawaiian Homes
2 Commission Act, 1920, as amended, principal purposes of the Act
3 are to place Hawaiians on the lands set aside under the Act in a
4 prompt and efficient manner, and to ensure long-term tenancy for
5 beneficiaries and their successors; and

7 WHEREAS, there remains an extensive waitlist of
8 beneficiaries attempting to obtain leases of Hawaiian home
9 lands; and

11 WHEREAS, under current practice, the Department of Hawaiian
12 Home Lands gives priority to persons on the waitlist based upon
13 their dates of application; and

15 WHEREAS, basing waitlist prioritization and awards on
16 lineal and generational descendance may be a more culturally
17 appropriate option, especially in rural and remote areas where
18 higher concentrations of these descendants remain; now,
19 therefore,

21 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
22 Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular
23 Session of 2024, the Senate concurring, that the Hawaiian Homes
24 Commission is urged to consult beneficiaries of the Hawaiian
25 Homes Commission Act regarding alternative waitlist and award
26 prioritization based upon lineal and generational descendance
27 for Hawaiian Home Lands located in Hana, Maui; and


