
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE AUDITOR TO CONDUCT A MANAGEMENT AND FINANCIAL
AUDIT OF THE HAWAII FILM AND CREATIVE INDUSTRIES
DEVELOPMENT SPECIAL FUND.

1 WHEREAS, film festivals have helped support Hawaii
2 filmmakers by promoting new and emerging talent in the State,
3 providing careers in creative media, increasing funding sources
4 for filmmaking, and supporting creative media collaborations
5 through educational programs; and
6

7 WHEREAS, film festivals in Hawaii attract tens of thousands
8 of viewers and generate millions of dollars in additional
9 spending and economic benefits; and
10

11 WHEREAS, the Hawaii Film and Creative Industries
12 Development Special fund was originally established by Act 285,
13 Session Laws of Hawaii 2000, as the Hawaii Television and Film
14 Development Special Fund whose purposes included awarding grants
15 for eligible Hawaii projects; and
16

17 WHEREAS, Act 193, Session Laws of Hawaii 2022, amended the
18 funding sources and authorized uses of the Hawaii Film and
19 Creative Industries Development Special Fund, the purpose of
20 which now includes providing seed capital for film, media,
21 electronic sports, and creative industries intellectual property
22 development projects; and
23

24 WHEREAS, however, the Hawaii Film and Creative Industries
25 Development Special Fund has been ineffective at supporting
26 Hawaii's filmmakers by failing to award grants for these
27 projects; and

29 WHEREAS, a management and financial audit of the Hawaii
30 Film and Creative Industries Development Special Fund could help

1 identify any shortcomings in the current distribution of funds
2 in the Special fund and determine any necessary changes to
3 increase the effectiveness of the Special Fund; now, therefore,
4

5 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
6 Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular
7 Session of 2024, the Senate concurring, that the Office of the
8 Auditor is requested to conduct a management and financial audit
9 of the Hawaii Film and Creative Industries Development Special
10 Fund; and
11

12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Office of the Auditor is
13 requested to submit a report of its management and financial
14 audit, including findings and recommendations and any proposed
15 legislation, to the Legislature no later than twenty days prior
16 to the convening of the Regular Session of 2025; and

18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
19 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Director of
20 Business, Economic Development, and Tourism; and Auditor.
