# HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE LEADERSHIP OF THE DEPARTMENT OF LAW ENFORCEMENT TO  
PERIODICALLY UNDERGO TRAINING ON CRIMES RELATING TO  
ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE TECHNOLOGY.

1 WHEREAS, technology is improving daily and at a rapid pace;

4 WHEREAS, artificial intelligence is a technological marvel  
5 that can advance workplace productivity, artistic expression,  
6 and entertainment; and

8 WHEREAS, like any technology, artificial intelligence can  
9 also be abused and used for criminal purposes; and

11 WHEREAS, law enforcement officers will likely investigate  
12 an increasing number of crimes relating to artificial  
13 intelligence in the upcoming years; now, therefore,

15 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the  
16 Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular  
17 Session of 2024, the Senate concurring, that the Director,  
18 Deputy Directors, and Administrators of the Department of Law  
19 Enforcement are urged to undergo training on crimes relating to  
20 artificial intelligence technology, including deepfakes and  
21 other related technologies, at least every two years; and

23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this  
24 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Director of Law
