# HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, IN PARTNERSHIP WITH THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU, TO INSTALL SPEED BUMPS, SPEED DETECTION DEVICES, PHOTO RED LIGHT IMAGING DETECTOR SYSTEMS, AND OTHER SAFETY MEASURES IN HOUSE DISTRICT 32.

1           WHEREAS, red light running is a significant cause of  
2 crashes, deaths, and injuries at signalized intersections; and  
3

4           WHEREAS, according to the Insurance Institute for Highway  
5 Safety (IIHS), 1,109 people were killed in crashes that involved  
6 red light running in 2021; and  
7

8           WHEREAS, an IIHS study found that red light cameras reduced  
9 the fatal red light running crash rate in large cities by  
10 twenty-one percent and the rate of all types of fatal crashes at  
11 signalized intersections by fourteen percent; and  
12

13           WHEREAS, Act 30, Session Laws of Hawaii 2020, established  
14 the Photo Red Light Imaging Detector Systems program and  
15 required the creation of a pilot program in Honolulu; and

17           WHEREAS, since the successful launch of the pilot program,  
18 areas in which red light cameras operate have seen a reduction  
19 in the number of crashes and a twenty to forty percent reduction  
20 in citations; and

22           WHEREAS, despite its success, the pilot program is limited  
23 to urban Honolulu; and

25           WHEREAS, placement of red light cameras in addition to  
26 speed bumps, speed detection devices, and other safety measures  
27 in the Fort Shafter, Moanalua, Aliamanu, and Foster Village  
28 areas will increase road safety and reduce fatal traffic  
29 incidents; now, therefore,

1 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the  
2 Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular  
3 Session of 2024, that the Department of Transportation, in  
4 partnership with the City and County of Honolulu, is requested  
5 to install speed bumps, speed detection devices, photo red light  
6 imaging detector systems, and other safety measures in House  
7 District 32; and

9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this  
10 Resolution be transmitted to the Director of Transportation and  
11 Mayor of the City and County of Honolulu.
