2 least forty-eight hours.

3 Every bill when passed by the house in which it originated,
4 or in which amendments thereto shall have originated, shall
5 immediately be certified by the presiding officer and clerk and
6 sent to the other house for consideration.

7 Any bill pending at the final adjournment of a regular
8 session in an odd-numbered year shall carry over with the same
9 status to the next regular session. Before the carried-over
10 bill is enacted, it shall pass at least one reading in the house
11 in which the bill originated."

12 SECTION 3. The question to be printed on the ballot shall
13 be as follows:

14 "Shall the Hawaii State Constitution be amended to allow an
15 electronic copy, as an alternative to a printed copy, of a
16 bill be made available to members of a house in which the
17 bill is being voted upon for third or final reading in
18 fulfillment of the forty-eight-hour availability
19 requirement?"

20 SECTION 4. New constitutional material is underscored.



1 SECTION 5. This amendment shall take effect upon
2 compliance with article XVII, section 3, of the Constitution of
3 the State of Hawaii.
