A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTIONS BY CANDIDATE COMMITTEES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 11-357, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 " ~~[+]§11-357[+]~~ **Contributions to candidate committees;**
4 **limits[-]; when prohibited.** (a) No person shall make
5 contributions to:

6 (1) A candidate seeking nomination or election to a
7 two-year office or to a candidate committee in an
8 aggregate amount greater than \$2,000 during an
9 election period;

10 (2) A candidate seeking nomination or election to a
11 four-year nonstatewide office or to a candidate
12 committee in an aggregate amount greater than \$4,000
13 during an election period; or

14 (3) A candidate seeking nomination or election to a
15 four-year statewide office or to a candidate committee
16 in an aggregate amount greater than \$6,000 during an
17 election period.



1 (b) For purposes of this section, the length of term of an
 2 office shall be the usual length of term of the office as
 3 unaffected by reapportionment, a special election to fill a
 4 vacancy, or any other factor causing the term of the office the
 5 candidate is seeking to be less than the usual length of term of
 6 that office.

7 (c) No elected official as defined in section 11-342(d)
 8 shall solicit or accept campaign contributions during any
 9 regular session or special session of the legislature, including
 10 any extension of any regular session or special session and any
 11 legislative recess day, holiday, or weekend."

12 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
 13 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
 14 begun before its effective date.

15 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
 16 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

17 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
