BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:


- 1 SECTION 1. (a) The public utilities commission shall
- 2 direct each electric and gas utility company in the State to
- 3 file proposals with the public utilities commission by
- 4 January 1, 2025, for programs to provide benefits to residential
- 5 property owners that:
- 6 (1) Reside in fire-prone areas within the service
- 7 territory of the electric or gas utility company; and
- 8 (2) Install improvements to reduce or eliminate the
- 9 impacts of wildfires on their residential properties
- or purchase emergency equipment or supplies for use in
- deenergization events.
- 12 Benefits shall include but not be limited to financial
- 13 assistance, rebates, subsidized tariffs or rates, and payment
- 14 programs.
- 15 (b) The public utilities commission may approve a program
- 16 pursuant to chapter 269, Hawaii Revised Statutes; provided that
- 17 the program or programs are found to be in the public interest.

PUC; Electric and Gas Utility Companies; Residential Property Wildfire Mitigation; Benefits Program

Description:

Requires the Public Utilities Commission to direct each electric and gas utility company in the State to file proposals for programs to provide certain benefits to residential property owners in fire-prone areas to reduce or eliminate the impacts of wildfires on residential properties or to purchase emergency equipment or supplies for use in deenergization events.
