A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
FIFTEENTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$32,401,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2024-2025
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the
6 fifteenth senatorial district, as follows:

7 1. Aliamanu Elementary School

8 A. Plans, design, and construction
9 for a chain link fence with gate
10 access to surround the campus.



2 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
3 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
4 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is
5 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation
6 unencumbered as of June 30, 2026, shall lapse as of that date.

7 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
8 capital improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be
9 expended for the purposes of this Act by the department of
10 education.

11 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2024.
