# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ADVISORY BOARDS.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 163D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately  
3 designated and to read as follows:

4           "§163D-        Advisory board. (a) There is established an  
5 advisory board to the corporation. The advisory board shall  
6 focus on workforce development for the agricultural industry.

7           (b) The board shall consist of the following members:

8           (1) The director of labor and industrial relations, or the  
9           director's designee;

10          (2) The superintendent of education, or the  
11          superintendent's designee;

12          (3) The vice president of university of Hawaii community  
13          colleges, or the vice president's designee;

14          (4) The executive director of the Hawaii natural energy  
15          institute at the university of Hawaii community  
16          colleges, or the vice president's designee; and



1       (5) Three individuals with appropriate experience,  
 2       appointed by the governor, whose terms shall end at  
 3       the end of each gubernatorial term; provided that the  
 4       governor may reappoint any member serving pursuant to  
 5       this paragraph; provided further that nongovernmental  
 6       members shall be invited by the governor to  
 7       participate.

8       (c) The advisory board shall meet as often as practicable,  
 9       but no less than once per \_\_\_\_\_.

10       (d) The appointed members of the advisory board shall  
 11       serve without compensation but shall be reimbursed for expenses,  
 12       including travel expenses, necessary for the performance of  
 13       their duties."

14       SECTION 2. Chapter 206M, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
 15       amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately  
 16       designated and to read as follows:

17       "§206M-        Advisory board. (a) There is established an  
 18       advisory board to the development corporation. The advisory  
 19       board shall focus on workforce development for the technology  
 20       industry.

21       (b) The board shall consist of the following members:



- 1        (1) The director of labor and industrial relations, or the  
2                director's designee;
- 3        (2) The superintendent of education, or the  
4                superintendent's designee;
- 5        (3) The vice president of university of Hawaii community  
6                colleges, or the vice president's designee;
- 7        (4) The executive director of the Hawaii natural energy  
8                institute at the university of Hawaii community  
9                colleges, or the vice president's designee; and
- 10       (5) Three individuals with appropriate experience,  
11               appointed by the governor, whose terms shall end at  
12               the end of each gubernatorial term; provided that the  
13               governor may reappoint any member serving pursuant to  
14               this paragraph; provided further that nongovernmental  
15               members shall be invited by the governor to  
16               participate.
- 17       (c) The advisory board shall meet as often as practicable,  
18       but no less than once per \_\_\_\_\_.
- 19       (d) The appointed members of the advisory board shall  
20       serve without compensation but shall be reimbursed for expenses,



1 including travel expenses, necessary for the performance of  
2 their duties."

3 SECTION 3. Chapter 227D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
4 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated  
5 and to read as follows:

6 "§227D- Advisory board. (a) There is established an  
7 advisory board to the authority. The advisory board shall  
8 focus on workforce development for the natural energy industry.

9 (b) The board shall consist of the following members:

10 (1) The director of labor and industrial relations, or the  
11 director's designee;

12 (2) The superintendent of education, or the  
13 superintendent's designee;

14 (3) The vice president of university of Hawaii community  
15 colleges, or the vice president's designee;

16 (4) The executive director of the Hawaii natural energy  
17 institute at the university of Hawaii community  
18 colleges, or the vice president's designee; and

19 (5) Three individuals with appropriate experience,  
20 appointed by the governor, whose terms shall end at  
21 the end of each gubernatorial term; provided that the



1           governor may reappoint any member serving pursuant to  
 2           this paragraph; provided further that nongovernmental  
 3           members shall be invited by the governor to  
 4           participate.


5           (c) The advisory board shall meet as often as practicable,  
 6           but no less than once per \_\_\_\_\_.

7           (d) The appointed members of the advisory board shall  
 8           serve without compensation but shall be reimbursed for expenses,  
 9           including travel expenses, necessary for the performance of  
 10          their duties."

11          SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.
